Before Co-op Meeting:

- 1. Review History Overview (Handbook) to understand philosophy and ideas behind this week's lesson.
- 2. Read:
 - \Box Aesop's Fables Kindness (DL)
- 3. Review Ancient Civilizations History Pocket 4 "Ancient Greece"
- 4. Gather and print materials needed for History Pocket 4: "Cut and Paste," "Fact Sheet," and "Student Booklet".

Lesson Goals:

- 1. To learn about the culture of Ancient Greece.
- 2. To begin to consider the significance of Greece's contributions to Western Culture.

At Co-op Preparation:

- □ Gather all materials and place them neatly to the side.
- □ Have paper towels and cleaning spray ready for clean-up time.

In Class:

- 1. Ask students what they know about the Ancient Greeks.
- 2. Read the "Fact Sheet: Ancient Greece" aloud.
- 3. Ask the students to list the important contributions of the Greeks.
- 4. Write down what the students say on a whiteboard, chalkboard, or large piece of paper for everyone to see.
- 5. Pass out Pocket materials and help students start the activities.
- 6. Instruct students to finish their Pocket at home.

Clean-up:

- □ Place the students' crafts to the side to dry on a table. These can be picked up by students at the end of the day.
- □ Use paper towels and cleaning spray to clean the tables if needed.
