Draw the Story/Coloring Page

Students will draw images from a story read aloud or color a coloring page.

Before Co-op Meeting:

- 1. Review History Overview (Handbook) to understand philosophy and ideas behind this week's lesson.
- 2. Read:
 - \Box Aesop's Fables Gratitude (DL)
- 3. Choose one or more stories from the weekly readings to read aloud in co-op.
- 4. Gather all the materials to have students draw a picture:
 - □ 1 piece of paper per student
 - \Box Crayons for students to share

~or~

□ 1 Coloring Page per student (SF)

Lesson Goals:

- 1. To learn about the moral lesson of kindness.
- 2. To draw or color a picture of one or more of Aesop's Fables.

At Co-op Preparation:

- □ Have the reading selection from *Aesop's Fables Kindness* prepared.
- Gather together all the materials needed to draw (paper and writing utensils).

In Class:

- 1. Instruct students that they are to draw the images from the story as they hear it.
- 2. Read the story aloud, pausing and helping students if necessary.
- 3. Have the students share their drawings with the class, describing the images in the drawing.
- 4. After everyone is finished with their drawing discuss the following questions.
 - □ What is the moral (the lesson to be learned) of the story?
 - □ What does that (the moral of kindness, or something similar) mean?
 - □ What are some examples of how you can show kindness (or a similar moral based on the story chosen)?
- 5. Instruct them to pick up their drawings at the end of co-op meeting.
