Before the Lesson:

- 1. Print and review this lesson.

- 3. Print 1 copy of **4-6 Activity A (SF)** per student.

Materials Needed:


This lesson.

Steps:

- 1. Pass out the picture "Shepard and Sheep" to all the students (based on *ILL 83*).
- 2. Ask students the following questions:
 - a. Describe the picture.
 - b. What time of year do you think it is? Give a reason for your answer.
 - c. What time of day do you think it is?
 - d. Which part of the picture interest you more, the sheep or the surroundings?
 - e. Does such a picture make you long to be in the woods?
 - f. What would you do if you had an afternoon to spend in such a place?
 - g. Of what use to a shepherd is a dog?
 - h. Tell any stories that you may have read about shepherd dogs.
- 3. Pass out and start on **4-6 Activity A.**
