

The First Sunday of Lent - Temptation

Before Co-op Meeting:

- 1. Read OHF-4, Ch. 18.3
- 2. Read CCC: 571-576
- 3. Pick a paragraph from the OHF-4 chapter to read aloud
- 4. Pack your books: OHF-4 and CCC

Lesson Goals:

- 1. To introduce the catechism chapter.
- To encourage students to practice a healthful process of enquiry about the Faith.
- 3. To consider the nature of temptation and manner in which Christ fulfils the law on our behalf

In Class:

- 1. Read the chosen selection from OHF-4
- 2. Discuss the selection for understanding, trying to grasp what it means.
- 3. Ask the students who can come up with the best or hardest question based upon the selection.
- 4. Take the question to the catechism—look up, read, and discuss the CCC's response
- 5. Ask questions related to the readings this week, for example:
 - What does it mean to be tempted?
 - What is the difference between being tempted and sinning?
 - How does fighting against temptation make us stronger?
 - How does it make us closer to Chrsit?
- Have students stand and recite the "Questions and Answers" aloud, see page 236
- Close with a brief prayer that especially reflects the themes of the week.
